Since the publication of the Annual Appeals Brochure a new project has been established and a summary is provided below as a supplement to the Brochure.

NEW RESEARCH PROJECT — CREATING THE CLIMATE FOR CHANGE: TACKLING GLOBAL WARMING THROUGH COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

This project will examine options for tackling global warming at the local, national and international level. It will commission leading local and international thinkers to prepare strategy discussion papers designed to promote public debate and influence policy development. The project will involve a series of forums where community leaders work with experts to foster community engagement in the development and implementation of strategies to tackle global warming.
