

Homes for Homes ...



- 1 Raises new funding
- Invests funds to increase supply of social and affordable housing
- 3 Complements existing activity



The gap between supply and demand for affordable housing is growing



How will funds be spent ...



- 1 H4H receives donations (\$)
- H4H allocates funds to specialist housing providers
 - Via competitive tenders
 - Guided by Housing & Investment Advisory Groups
 - Funds raised in a state are invested in that state
- 3 Housing providers will deliver & manage housing



H4H funds increase supply of social & affordable housing


