Dr Nonie Brennan, who drastically reduced homelessness in Chicago, Illinois, returns to Adelaide as our next Thinker in Residence next week.

Under Dr Brennan's leadership, Chicago homelessness was reduced by 25 per cent since 2015, with an impressive 10,000 people housed in two years!
